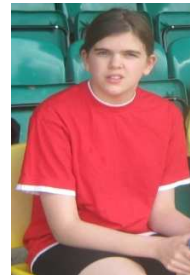
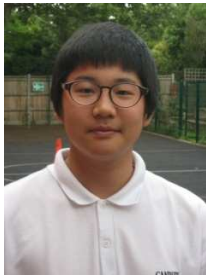


Canbury News
